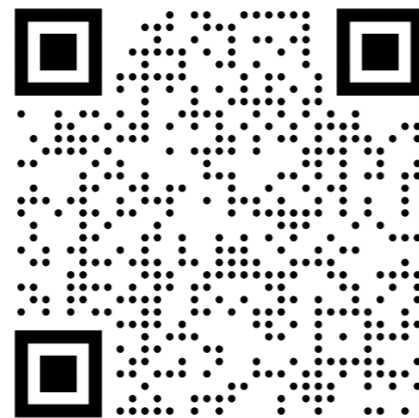
Erfurt – Study in the **green** heart of Germany

- visa is not required for students from (e.g.): EU countries, Switzerland, the USA, Japan
- application for visa at a German embassy or consulate in your home country
- necessary document: Letter of (conditional) admission of the University of Erfurt



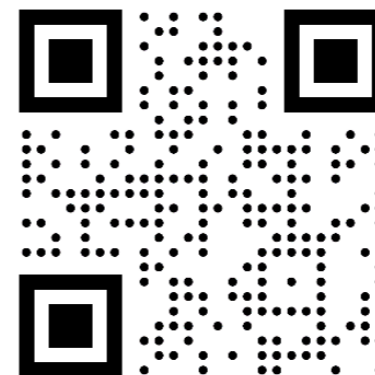

3 GENERAL HINTS:

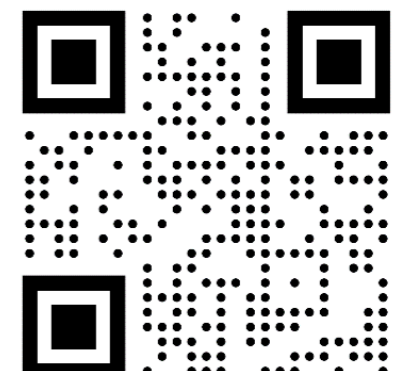
1. Apply for your visa as early as possible!
