# Let's go!

You have *fulfilled* all *admission requirements* and *received* a *letter of admission* to study at the University of Erfurt? Then there are only a few steps left before you can start your studies. Here you can find out what those steps are!

With your letter of admission, you must *apply for a study visa* in your home country at a *German embassy* as early as possible.



If you have been admitted to an admission-restricted Bachelor's programme or a Master's programme, you must not forget to *accept* your *place in time* by applying for enrolment in the application portal.

# To Do

## Step 1

Click on the button in the application portal *„Request for enrolment“* and follow the instructions.



## Step 2

Print and sign the enrolment request document and send it by postal mail *to the International Office* with the required documents listed in the enrolment request.
