Drawing on a social science perspective and focusing on Italy - particularly Romanian migration - this presentation examines the implications of the growing entanglements and transformative dynamics shaping the multiplicity of immigrant churches and Christian movements in Europe. It highlights the crucial changes and contemporary challenges in the transnational life of the multitude of immigrant Christianities, which contribute to new aspects of European religious diversity and foster fresh Christian forms.
