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## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

#### **Research and Graduate Services**

We, the team of the Research and Graduate Services, develop strategies and concepts directing research, research funding and the promotion of early career researchers at the University of Erfurt. In close cooperation with the university governance and numerous researchers, we focus on ideas for research and fundings and transfer these into various programs, instruments, and events, which we implement and supervise. In addition, we support researchers at the University of Erfurt, who aim to receive external funding for their research projects.

The Research and Graduate Services is generally available for consulting at all career stages. In addition to comprehensive, personal consulting services, we offer doctoral candidates structural and financial support (e.g. by memberships in the Graduate Centers or by organizing workplaces, scholarships), a platform for discussions with other doctoral candidates or presenting your own research beyond your usual expert audience (e.g. the Christoph Martin Wieland Forum Discussions or the Erfurt Science Slam). ## CAREER FUNDING | INTERNAL ANNOUNCEMENTS

### University of Erfurt announces initialisation scholarships

The University of Erfurt intends to award initialisation scholarships to female postdoctoral researchers from 1 June 2024 as part of the "Federal and State Programme for Women Professors" and the "Thuringian Programme for the Promotion of Young Women Researchers and Young Women Artists". The funding is aimed at excellent female researchers in the qualification phase who want to design a third-party funding application to carry out an independently planned research project as part of the scholarship.

The call for applications is open to all topics. A connection between the project and the Gotha Research Centre or the Forschungskolleg Transkulturelle Studien / Perthes Collection in terms of subject and content is desirable, but not a prerequisite. The duration of the scholarships is up to 12 months. Depending on the programme, funding includes a monthly stipend of 1,600 or 2,000 euros as well as a family allowance and, if applicable, an annual lump sum for research costs. In addition, the scholarship includes targeted support in the preparation of the third-party funding application, workshops as part of the "Academic Qualification Programme" and individual application coaching for the planned third-party funding project.

#### **Research Grants for Female Research Associates**

From the budget for gender equality measures of the Equal Opportunity and Family Office, research grants can now be paid to (post)doctoral researcher associates of the University of Erfurt, e.g., for conference travel, for researcher funds, data access, additional equipment, etc.

Doctoral candidates can apply for support of up to 300€ and postdoctoral researchers can apply for support of up to 500€.

Informal applications with a breakdown of costs are accepted prior to travel via <u>gleichstellungsbuero@uni-erfurt.de</u>. When applying for travel grants for conference travel, the certificate of acceptance of your own conference contribution must also be attached to the application.

**Reimbursement of Research Costs for Female Doctoral Scholarship Holders** From the budget for gender equality measures of the Equal Opportunity and Family Office, it is possible for female doctoral scholarship holders of the University of Erfurt to be reimbursed an additional 300€ per year for research costs. The funds can be applied for in addition to the existing funds for research and travel costs by membership in one of the Graduate Centers.

For the application, original invoices, proofs of payment as well as confirmations of participation or similar proofs for event participations and travels must be submitted.

#### Max Weber Award for Young Researchers 2024

The Max Weber Centre for Advanced Cultural and Social Studies at the University of Erfurt (Max-Weber-Kolleg) will once again be awarding the Max Weber Award for Young Researchers in 2024. This prize is intended to honour the outstanding work of a young researcher in the context of a Weberian research programme, i.e. in the field of interdisciplinary cultural and social studies with historical depth and/or interest in normative questions. Submissions can be made for dissertation or habilitation thesis written in English or German completed in the years 2022 to 2023.

The prize has a volume of 1,500 EUR. In addition, the Max-Weber-Kolleg pays the travel expenses within Europe for the journey to the award ceremony.

Applications can be sent by **15 June 2024**.

## COMPETENCE-ORIENTED PERSONNEL DEVELOPMENT FOR ACADEMICS

Below you will find the workshops and events of the summer semester which are offered as part of the Academic Skills Training and in which places are still available:

- <u>Führung von Mitarbeiter\*innen in der Wissenschaft</u> (8 April 2024, 9 a.m. to 1 p.m., in German):

The workshop aims for advanced postdocs and (junior) professors. In the workshop, you will learn the basics of (appreciative) personnel management, reflect on your leadership role and your own leadership actions and further develop your individual leadership skills. The challenges you face in everyday management are discussed in a practice-oriented manner.

- <u>Karriere innerhalb und außerhalb der Hochschule</u> (4 June 2024, 2 to 4 p.m., German):

This two-hour online event is open to doctoral candidates, doctoral candidates, postdocs, and all other interested members of the University of Erfurt. In the event, four speakers will introduce themselves and give an insight into the course and steps of their respective careers. Two speakers work at universities and the two other speakers work in science administration or outside of universities.

Afterwards, you will have the opportunity to ask them questions. A certificate of attendance cannot be issued.

- <u>Promotion Ja oder nein?</u> (10 & 11 June 2024, each 2 to 5 p.m., German): This workshop is aimed at Master's students or those interested in doing a doctorate (with an interest in doing a doctorate at the University of Erfurt). The workshop offers an overview of all important aspects when deciding whether to do a doctorate. In addition to several trainer inputs, there will also be opportunities to ask questions, exchange ideas and reflect on decision-relevant issues.
- <u>FAIR and efficient Research Data Management</u> (14 June 2024, 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., English):

The workshop is aimed at doctoral candidates and postdoctoral researchers. The course deals with the practical implementation of data management. Topics include, among others, policies, guidelines and legal framework, data management plans or data publication and archiving.

## INFORMATION FROM THE COMMITTEE OF PHD REPRESENTATIVES

The doctoral representation is the joint representation of the doctoral candidates at the University of Erfurt. It promotes the interdisciplinary, cooperative, and international doctoral culture at the University of Erfurt and campaigns for the interests of doctoral candidates in the university's internal committees. With various events, it also provides information on topics relevant to doctoral studies and contributes to interdisciplinary and inter-faculty exchange and networking among doctoral students.

The doctoral student representation is made up of one member and one deputy per faculty and the Max-Weber-Kolleg. The term of office is one year, and the term of office starts on the 1<sup>st</sup> of October each year.

**Completion Scholarship for Doctoral Candidates by Stiftung Ettersberg** The "Stiftung Ettersberg" (Ettersberg Foundation) is awarding a scholarship to complete a doctorate by 1 July 2024. Funding is provided for doctoral projects that make a scientific contribution to the history of the European dictatorship and its overcoming.

The funding includes a scholarship of 1,150.00 euros per month and has a duration of six months.

# The Krupp-Foundation Fellowship for Visiting Student Researchers at Stanford

The Alfried Krupp von Bohlen und Halbach Foundation is offering up to three research scholarships to German doctoral students in the humanities to enable them to spend 3 to 6 months at Stanford University in California (USA). The scholarship is due to start at the beginning of January 2025. Scholarship holders will receive 3,000 euros per month as well as a one-off lump sum of 3,000 euros for travel expenses and visa fees.

## "Rolle und Macht im System Hochschule" – Workshop organized by the Office for Equal Opportunity and Family Services

This workshop invites you to take an analytical look at the topic of power and teaches you how to analyse explicit and implicit power constellations in the university context. The space for a constructive examination of one's own approaches to the power associated with (guided) tours in academia makes it possible to reflect on one's own attitude to power in the university context. The reflection serves to develop appropriate strategies for dealing with positive and negative, functional or destructive exercises of power in order to expand one's own repertoire of action.

The workshop is aimed at professors & habilitated employees, doctoral students & postdocs. We work in homogeneous status groups in the morning and deepen the topic in the afternoon with both groups in transfer.

## DAAD Information Session PRIME (Postdoctoral Researchers International Mobility Experience)

PRIME offers temporary employment at a German university and is not a conventional scholarship. The 18 months of funding include a mandatory yearlong stay abroad. The program is open to all those who have completed their doctorate at the start of the funding period and have at least one published publication to show by the application deadline. The target group of the program are young scientists who see their professional career in Germany in the long term.

The German National Academy of Sciences (Leopoldina) awards two-year postdoctoral fellowships to postdoctoral researchers from Germany, Austria and Switzerland who completed their doctorate no more than seven years ago for a research stay abroad. The scholarship includes a basic scholarship of 1,750.00 euros per month and monthly material resources of 250.00 euros.

Applications can be submitted on an ongoing basis. Award decisions are made three times a year.

## Election of the members of the University of Erfurt's Awards and Grant Commission

The Awards and Grant Commission is a central body of the University of Erfurt and is elected by the Senate. Its task is to determine whether the requirements for the award of a scholarship have been met. Scholarship extensions are also assessed by the Awards and Grant Commission. In addition, it fulfils conceptual tasks in the scholarship system and forwards proposals in this regard to the Executive Board and the Senate.

New representatives are to be elected for the Awards and Grant Commission. This also applies to members from the graduate group. We would like to encourage scholarship holders at the University of Erfurt to participate in the Awards and Grant Commission and stand as candidates for election at the Senate meeting on 12 June 2024. This is a great opportunity to gain practical experience with the work of an internal university committee and to be able to actively participate in it.

The **term of office** is two years: 1 July 2024 to 30 June 2026. Our call is therefore aimed at scholarship holders whose regular funding phase roughly corresponds to this period. We hope to be able to recruit you for the interesting work in the Awards and Grant Commission and would be delighted if you would stand for election as a candidate.

Please let us know whether you would like to stand as a **main member OR a deputy**. We are looking for two main members and two deputies.

We also need a short CV from you for the nomination.
