WHO CAN GET A BUDDY?

All international students are eligible to join the programme once they have **enrolled** at the University <u>of Erfurt</u>. The programme focuses on first-semester students, but depending on our internal capacity, students in higher semesters may also get a buddy.

YOUR BUDDY HELPS YOU WITH

- the first steps in the city and at the university (see the checklist below)
- integrating and meeting new people
- questions on general university matters (e.g. thoska, library, enrolment in courses, re-registration)

DO's AND DON'Ts

- Spend time with your buddy and get to know each other there are certainly lots of new things to discover together! For example, you may like to invite your buddy over and cook a typical dish.
- Please keep in mind that the buddies join the programme as volunteers. Therefore, they are not responsible for providing you with, for example, a place to stay, help in financial emergencies or translation services. Buddies may offer you help with university assignments and procedures if they are able to
