Doctoral Scholarships

The University of Erfurt combines a unique profile in the fields of culture, education, social sciences, and humanities with a vibrant, interdisciplinary research culture. Doctoral students can expect an inspiring environment with personalized guidance, a wide range of opportunities for specialized and interdisciplinary training, and a modern research infrastructure. On the green campus, not far from the historic old town, they will find ideal conditions for independent research, academic exchange, and a successful doctoral programme.

The University of Erfurt awards scholarships from funds of the Thuringian State Graduate Support to doctoral candidates as part of its structured doctoral programme (EPPP) from **1 April 2027**.

The doctoral scholarship includes a funding of **€1,400 per month** with an extra family-allowance (€300 for one / the first child plus €150 for any further child) and is granted for three years. The funding can be extended for another year.
