Digital Summer Semester 2020 of the University of Erfurt: II

Dear students,

last week I promised to provide you with more information on how to access the moodle rooms of your courses.

We have made the following arrangement for this purpose throughout the university:

Since there is no possibility this semester to provide you with the access data to the moodle room of your courses in the first classroom session, I would like to suggest the following procedure. We have differentiated between three scenarios in the preparation and have made the preparation for this as follows:

a. Preparation

We have asked all teachers to set the same access key for access to certain moodle rooms. This way you don't have to contact the teachers by email to ask for it and you can easily register in the corresponding moodle rooms.

Universal access key: Stawi2020

b. Lectures

These are free courses within the university. All students of the University of Erfurt use the universal access key "Stawi2020" for access and every student can participate in the lecture.

c. Seminars/courses with unknown participants

Here too, you enter the universal access key "Stawi2020" and can participate in the moodle room. After 1 - 2 weeks, the respective teachers will decide which of you can participate. The other students will be excluded from the room, similar to the procedure for classroom teaching.

d. Seminars/courses with known participants and their e-mail addresses

For these courses the respective lecturers will inform you of the specific access key by e-mail.

e. A request: Please be patient with us, the teachers. We are all working feverishly to provide and furnish the rooms with the documents, contents, tasks and activities. The teachers will "unlock" the rooms in the coming week so that you can log in with the universal access key or send you an e-mail with the specific access key. Therefore, please refrain from sending e-mails to the teachers if some rooms are not yet unlocked or some e-mails have not yet been distributed on Monday morning at 00:00.

Finally, I would like to respond to a rumour that has come to our attention regarding the start of the lecture period in the winter semester.

You are all following the social debate on the political decisions to be taken in the Corona pandemic. Then you also know that the Abitur examinations will be postponed. As a result, the distribution and admission procedures will also have to be postponed. The KMK (Standing Conference of Ministers of Education and Cultural Affairs) has therefore decided that the lecture period for the first semesters of these courses of study should start on 2.11.2020 at the earliest. The regulations for the other courses of study have been left to the universities, because specific organisational conditions have to be observed at each university location.

The University of Erfurt has not yet made any regulations at the start of the winter semester lecture period, but will discuss and decide on them in the coming weeks. You and our lecturers will be the first to be informed of this decision. Please be assured that, in addition to the requirements of the KMK, the interests of all those involved will be taken into account.

Last but not least: It will not surprise you that the process of course enrolment and module examinations as well as other examination-related processes will also have to be adjusted this semester. In the coming days, you will receive another e-mail from the Department 1 Studies and Teaching with the necessary information.

I wish you a reasonable start to the first digital semester at the University of Erfurt and, despite the special circumstances, an interesting and instructive semester. For us lecturers it certainly will be.
