18/11/2020**Announcement for the FSR elections of the University of Erfurt**

The student council (FSR) elections of the University of Erfurt will take place from December 16th, 2020 (12:00 p.m.) to December 18th, 2020 (12:00 p.m.) as an (internet-based) electronic election. The submitted voting papers will be counted publicly on December 18th, 2020 from 12:00 p.m. We ask that you register in advance by December 9th, 2020, if you want to watch the count. The election results will be announced on December 18th, 2020.

Nominations for candidates can be submitted from November 18th, 2020 to December 2nd, 2020 at 4:00 p.m. via the relevant form available at the High Student Council (StuRa) office or electronically by email. Forms for nominations are available at the High Student Council office or online. The electoral roll is available to the university public in the High Student Council office until November 25th, 2020. Anyone who is entered in the electoral register of a student council may vote and be elected.

The appendix lists which student councils are elected, who are the members of the student council with passive and active voting rights and which modules apply to the election. Please note that you may be a member of several student councils. In this case you have the active and passive right to vote in both student councils.

The election regulations of the High Student Council apply to the elections of the student councils. This applies in connection with the ordinance on student council elections in connection with the corona-related restrictions in the summer semester 2020 and winter semester 2020/2021 and the respective ordinances of the student council, if available.

The election documents will be sent electronically to the university email address of those entitled to vote by December 9th, 2020. The voting documents consist of the election letter with the access data as well as information on how to vote and how to use the voting portal. Voting takes place via SecureLink with the POLYAS CORE 2.2.3 voting system. Online voting is accessible via the university's intranet.

According to §6 (2) of the election regulations of the student body of the University of Erfurt from May 8th, 2020, there is the possibility of postal voting. A person entitled to vote who is unable to vote at the time of the election or cannot participate for other reasons will receive separate postal voting documents for the election upon written or electronic request. Postal voting documents can be requested until December 2nd, 2020 at 12:00 p.m. Voting is deemed to have taken place on time

if the election letter will be received by the election management on December 18, 2020 by the end of the voting time at 12:00pm. Please contact [stura.wahl@uni-erfurt.de](mailto:stura.wahl@uni-erfurt.de) for submitting nominations, applying for postal voting documents, changes to the electoral roll and other questions.

Please make use of your passive and active voting rights. Propose someone or run yourself. Be sure to take part in the election!

\* In the Student Government, 1 spokesperson, 1 deputy spokesperson, 1 student representative (1st year of study), 1 social planner (1st year of study), 1 student representative (2nd + year of study), 1 social planner (2nd year of study) are appointed . The individual positions are listed on the ballot paper. The people are elected directly into the positions, with the positions functioning like constituencies. I.e. the person with the most votes for a position takes that position and becomes a member of the Student Government.
