

Registration in person is necessary to borrow books. This is possible for everyone and **free of charge**. Please bring the following documents.





Declaration of consent of the parents




thoska for students from other universities in Thuringia

All other applicants (e.g. pupils) will get a new library card.

Students of the University of Erfurt: 13 months

All other users: 2 years


thoska as library card
