The Willy Brandt School of Public Policy at the University of Erfurt is seeking to fill the following full-time position (40 hours/week) starting **01.10.2021** or as soon as possible:

Research Associate

Internationalization and Digitization of Teaching

Pay group 13 TV-L (100 %)

Responsibilities:

- Initiation of cooperation activities that would lead into joint programs (joint/double degree, cotutelle)
- Acquisition of third-party funds to support the initiated cooperations
- Conceptualization of joint formats with selected partners abroad
- Development of new teaching formats and tools that can simplify and improve the delivery of international teaching formats (hybrid, online, intercultural) in the fields of Public Policy and Social Sciences (e.g. Public Administration/Public Economics or Conflict Studies and Management), also taking into account the mental health of the participants
- Teaching responsibilities to test the developed teaching formats in the above-mentioned content areas (2 LVS)

Requirements:

- Completed academic university studies (diploma/MA/state examination) in public policy, social sciences, economics or law, ideally with a doctoral degree
- Knowledge of the international higher education and cooperation landscape
- Experience in the field of university cooperation or exchange partnerships
- Teaching experience in an international environment, ideally in English
- Experience in the acquisition and management of third-party funding
- Technical skills in hybrid and online teaching
- Fluency in English and German, both written and spoken
- Intercultural competence

Additional notes:

The position is limited to 2 years in accordance with project approval, but after possible employment opportunity on 01.01.2022, the position ends with the project end on 31.12.2023.
