We are looking to fill positions in the fields of sociology, political science, history, religious studies, philosophy, law, South Asian studies, and economics. Through interdisciplinary collaboration between these disciplines, the SFB aims to (re)gain a comprehensive social-theoretical perspective on issues of property and to investigate current structural changes to the nature of property.
