documents for the habilitation application



According to § 5 *Habilitationsordnung* (Habilitation Regulations) the following information and documents are required to apply for the opening of the habilitation procedure:

- written application with the following information:
 - designation of the subject(s) for which the applicant intends to habilitate
 - proposal of assessors:
 - o at least 3 for the assessment of the written habilitation thesis: one from within the faculty and one from an another university as well as one additional person
 - o 2 for the examination of pedagogical-didactic aptitude
 - notification as to whether the authorisation to teach (*Lehrbefugnis*) pursuant according to § 7
 Habilitation Regulations is also being applied for
 - members of the Max-Weber-Kolleg (MWK): indication of whether the habilitation is carried out in cooperation with the MWK.
- Curriculum vitae with a description of the personal, professional and scientific background
- documentary proof of the doctorate (certified copy of the certificate or diploma)
- written habilitation thesis in five printed copies and in a text-identical electronic version (PDF);
 if the habilitation thesis consists of several publications (cumulative habilitation), these and a list of
 them must be enclosed and submitted together with an umbrella publication; if several persons are
 involved in individual publications, your own contribution to the publication and that of the other
 authors must be precisely broken down; all co-authors must confirm their stated contributions in
 writing
- **declaration of honour** (according annex 1 of *Habilitation Regulations*)
- three proposals for the topic of the scientific presentation within the framework of the oral habilitation performance; including short abstracts, max. ½ page each; the topics should not substantially overlap with each other or with your habilitation thesis or dissertation
- · complete list of (scientific) publications
- **list of courses taught so far**; if applicable, supplemented by evidence of further qualification in higher education didactics and/or results of teaching evaluations
- **official clearance certificate**; unless the applicant is a member of the University of Erfurt or belongs to the German public service
- written statement on criminal and disciplinary convictions as well as pending criminal and disciplinary proceedings
- written statement on any previous or simultaneous applications for habilitation elsewhere
- **receipt for the habilitation fee paid** (see <u>Allgemeine Gebührenordnung der Universität Erfurt</u> in German only); please request the bank details at the Dean's office.
