pages	title page: title of paper student's name, matriculation number, major & minor fields of study, e-mail address title of course and name of instructor, semester, date of submission table of content (<i>Gliederung</i> , not needed for short essay assignments) introduction body of argument, structured in paragraphs conclusion bibliography: listing all works cited in MLA Style (format see next page) declaration of authorship, signed (text see below)
margins	2.5 cm on all sides page numbers in lower right-hand corner
font	Times New Roman 12 pt 1.5 space 1.25 cm indentation for first line of each paragraph quotations longer than 3 lines need to be set off as separate, indented paragraph <i>italics</i> for all book titles and foreign words (NB: essay titles are indicated by “Quotation Marks”) 10 pt footnotes for additional clarifications (keep to a minimum)
references	in-text citation, MLA style, see http://owl.english.purdue.edu/owl/resource/747/02/ Observe correct sequence of citation marks, parenthesis, and punctuation marks!
direct quotations	Wordsworth stated that Romantic poetry was marked by a “spontaneous overflow of powerful feelings” (263).
paraphrases	Wordsworth extensively explored the role of emotion in the creative process (263).
binding/ format	printed copy: A4 size paper, paper clip or ordinary clip-in binder digital copy: MS Word (.docx), Rich Text (.rtf), or PDF (.pdf)
declaration of authorship	“Hiermit versichere ich an Eides statt, dass ich die vorliegende Arbeit selbstständig und ohne fremde Hilfe verfasst und keine anderen als die angegebenen Quellen und Hilfsmittel benutzt habe, alle Ausführungen, die anderen Schriften wörtlich oder sinngemäß entnommen wurden, gekennzeichnet sind und die Arbeit in gleicher oder ähnlicher Form noch kein Bestandteil einer Studien- oder Prüfungsleistung war.”
