I first studied cultural work for three semesters at FH Potsdam, then switched to Humboldt University of Berlin for a B.A. and M.A. Alongside my studies, I built up my multimedia knowledge platform SchwarzRund. During the research work for my first novel Biskaya (2016) I discovered my passion for historical studies.
