During the AÜV / WCL Annual Conference we are provided with two hotels in Erfurt.

I Radisson Blu Hotel to the University of Erfurt

From the *Radisson Blu* Hotel to the University of Erfurt it takes about 20 minutes. The best way to get there is to take the tram.

Walk along *Krämpferstraße* in the direction of the city center and turn left at the intersection of *Johannesstraße* and *Meienbergstraße* in the direction of *Anger*. At *Anger* in the city center, walk straight across the square towards the *Hugendubel* store.

Opposite the store you will find the *Anger* tram station, platform 4.

Take the tram line 3 in the direction of *Europaplatz*, or line 6 in the direction of *Rieth* and get off at the station "*Universität*".



I Hotel Kaisersaal to the University of Erfurt

From the Hotel *Kaisersaal* you should plan about 15 minutes. Again, the best way to reach the university is by tram.

Walk out of the hotel to the left on the *Futterstraße* and walk straight across the *Krämerbrücke*. After the bridge, walk straight on *Benediktsplatz* until you reach the *Fischmarkt*.

Directly opposite the town hall on your left side you will see the tram station *Fischmarkt/Rathaus*. From here you can use the tram lines 3 direction Europaplatz or 6 direction *Rieth* and get off at the station "*Universität*".




USEFUL DIRECTIONS

I From the tram station "University" to the Senate Hall ("Senatssaal")

From the tram stop, cross the street to enter the main entrance of the university. From there, you will already see the "*Mitarbeitergebäude 1*" on your left, the highest building on campus. Enter this building and take the elevator (or the stairs) to the top floor of the building, where the Senatssaal is located.

I Covid rules

- FFP2 masks are obligatory in public transportation in Erfurt
- FFP2 or OP masks are required on the premises of the university

I Where to buy a tram ticket

All places in Erfurt can be easily reached by tram.

With the monthly **9 Euro ticket** on offer for June, July and August across Germany, you can use all local transport vehicles. If you would like to use it, make sure you also have one that is valid from 1 July, the second day of the conference. If you prefer to buy a ticket for local transport, we recommend three different alternatives to buy tickets for your rides.

The first option is the **ticket app FAIRTIQ**. With this app, all journeys are automatically accounted for and booked with your chosen payment method.

1. download the app FAIRTIQ from your app store. Here are the links for the app in the Apple and Google App Store.

- 2. log in to the registration form with your name and a desired payment method (Paypal, VISA, credit card).
- 3. allow the location access "always" on your smartphone.
- 4. press the "Start" button when you start your first ride by sliding the button to the right.
- 5. when they are checked on the tram, click the "Show Ticket" button in the middle of their screen on the app.
- 6. press the button "End journey" or "Exit" on your smartphone
- 7. the trip will be saved and calculated automatically.

Attention: Your location tracking must remain switched on during the entire journey.

The second option is to buy a ticket at a **ticket machine**.

Among other places, there is a ticket vending machine at the main train station. After selecting the desired language, you can buy various tickets under the heading "Single and day tickets".


We recommend buying a day ticket "Tagesticket" for 5,60 Euro, as they are worth it from three rides per day.
