

Hiob Ludolf-Fellowships at the Research Library Gotha and the Gotha Research Centre of Erfurt University

The Herzog-Ernst-Scholarship Programme of the Fritz Thyssen Foundation at the Research Library Gotha and the Gotha Research Centre of the University of Erfurt aims to promote academic research by providing access to the resources of the Research Library and of the associated historic collection of the Justus Perthes Gotha Publishing House as well as collections held in the Gotha Friedenstein Castle. In 2019 we offer Hiob Ludolf-Fellowships for established national and international scholars again.

Senior scholars are invited to apply for a Hiob Ludolf-Fellowship, which includes a monthly grant of up to € 1,200 for one or two months to help cover travel and boarding expenses. You will also be provided with a fully equipped office and access to the infrastructure of the Research Centre.

Closing date for applications: 15th October 2018

Earliest starting date: 1st February 2019

Applicants are requested to include the following documents to their application:

1. Covering Letter, including the desired time of stay
2. Curriculum Vitae
3. A brief outline of the project (2–5 pages) including a statement why it is necessary to do research in Gotha
4. A list of publications
